# What is the Smart Cities Concept?

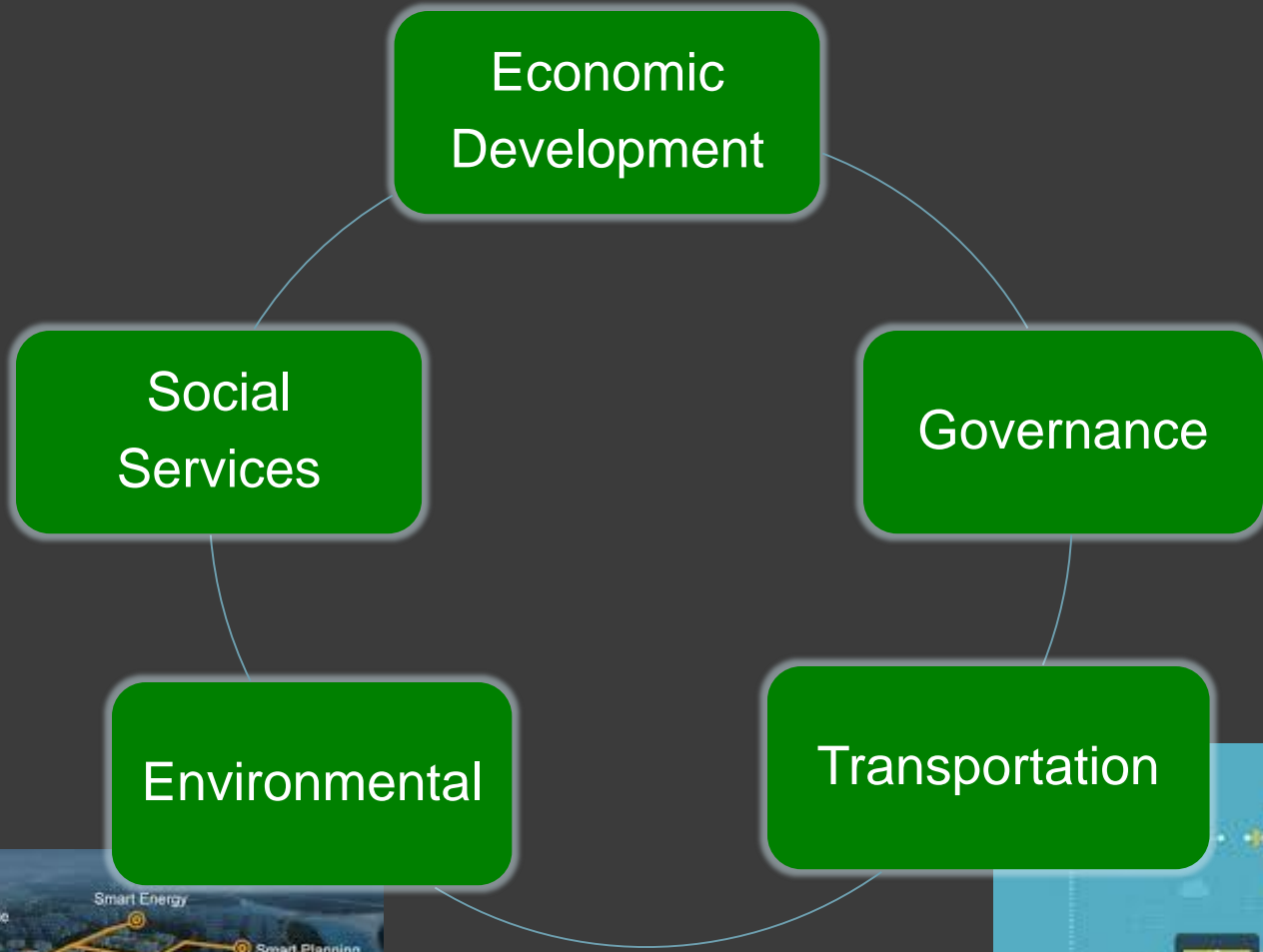
## ○ The White House Smart Cities Initiative:
