BROADBAND GOALS

- Increase the percent of Nevadans that have access to broadband for cities, hospitals, clinics, libraries, schools, and public safety.
- Increase the percent of Nevada schools and libraries that have access to broadband at speeds that meet national benchmarks.
- By 2025, connect all rural hospitals, health clinics, and state correctional facilities to a broadband connection sufficient to provide tele-health services.
