A vendor's response should include two options for the switch; 1) complete pricing for a turn-key solution, and 2) pricing for the switch drop-shipped or otherwise delivered to the school without installation.

All bids must include all costs associated with delivering and installing the equipment to each school, including but not limited to shipping, delivery, travel, per diem, installation, sales tax (if applicable) and any other related charges. Show all charges as separate line item charges and provide the E-rate eligibility of each product.

Basic maintenance will be requested on the Form 470 since USAC may consider licenses to be basic maintenance.
